We celebrated the day in collaboration with our Chinese counterpart school. We share with you the tribute that Tagoreans have put together for the Bard of Bengal.




INTERHOUSE COMPETITIONS

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
Observing International Day Against Homphobia, Biphobia and Transphobia on 17 May'21

A Workshop on 'Strategies Beyond Academics and Profile Building' on 07 May


