CIRCULAR FOR CLASSES IX

Dear Parent

As per the circular issued by the Directorate of Education on 01.9.2021 regarding the Scheme of Assessment for the Academic Session 2021-22, the Term I examination for Class IX is to be conducted in October / November 2021.

In compliance with the order, we are rescheduling the Term I Examination for Class IX which will also bring in a change in the schedule of classes. Kindly note the following with respect to the same:

Term I Examination will now be conducted from Friday, 22 October to Monday, 01 November. This examination will be conducted OFFLINE in the school. (Schedule for the same will be shared by Friday, 17 September.)

The revised plan for teaching classes is as follows:

- 1. Monday, 06 September to Wednesday, 08 September- revision will be held in the hybrid (Offline + Online) mode. **ONLINE** classes will be conducted for all the students on Thursday, 09 and Friday, 10 September.
- Term II syllabus will be taught from Thursday, 09 September till Tuesday, 05 October. The time table for these classes will remain the same as shared on Friday, 03 September. All these classes will be conducted in the hybrid mode.
- 3. Revision for Term I syllabus will be done from Wednesday, 06 to Tuesday, 12 October.
- 4. Dussehra holidays will be from Wednesday, 13 to Wednesday, 20 October.
- 5. Thursday, 21 October will be a preparatory leave.

Pattern for the Term I Examination is as follows:

- Question papers will have Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) including Case Based & Assertion Reasoning Type to be attempted on OMR sheets. The duration of the examination will be 90 minutes.
- There will be no oral component for the Term I Examination.

With the revised schedule of teaching and examination, if you wish for your ward to attend offline classes, you are requested to fill the **Google form** (link given below) again and submit the same by Tuesday, 07 Sept by 05:00 pm.
