## 1. Letters of Recommendation (LORs):

Most reputed Indian and international universities require Letters of Recommendation from the Principal or teachers of the school last attended.

## 2. Content of LORs:

These letters highlight a student's academic performance, participation in co-curricular involvement, individual achievements, and contributions to social causes. LORs play a crucial role in the university selection process.

# 3. Building a Strong Portfolio:

It is essential that your ward is aware of this requirement and actively works toward building well-rounded profile through consistent academic effort and involvement in various domains academic, co-curricular and community service.

## 4. Eligibility criteria for LORs:

The school will issue Letters of Recommendation **ONLY** to students who secure **75% or above** in **Class XI Final Assessment**. This benchmark has been set because most top Indian and foreign universities do not accept applications from students scoring below 75%.

#### 5. Predicted Scores:

Universities also require predicted academic scores, which will be based entirely on Class XI Final results. Hence, it is imperative that your ward approaches her/his studies with seriousness and dedication.

#### 6. Financial Considerations:

Please note that the tuition fees and living expenses of several international universities are comparable to those of top Indian institutions.

We seek your support in encouraging your ward to remain focused and committed, as this is a critical phase that will shape her/his academic future.
